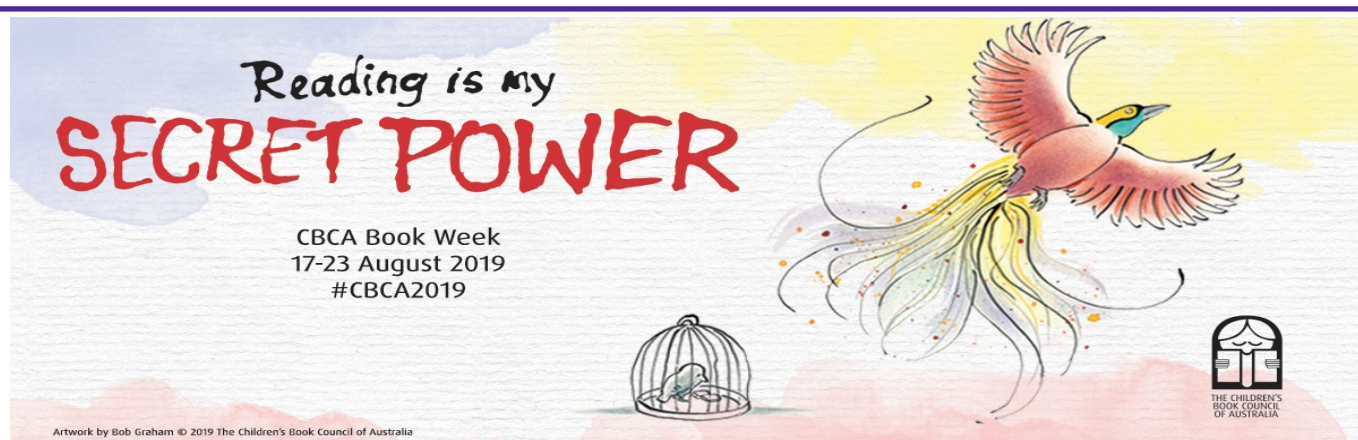
School Council

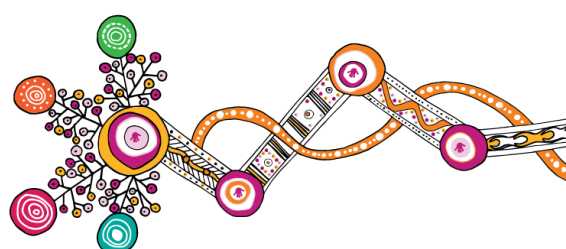
