KEEPING YOUR DISTANCE.




To keep us all safe at Mildura Primary School, the bubble taps have been turned off.

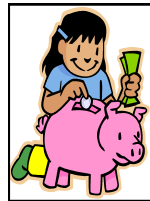
Please remember to send a water bottle to school each day with your child. Students are able to refill water bottles if they need to.

Student Banking

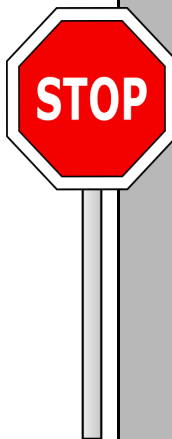
Student banking will recommence in term 3
