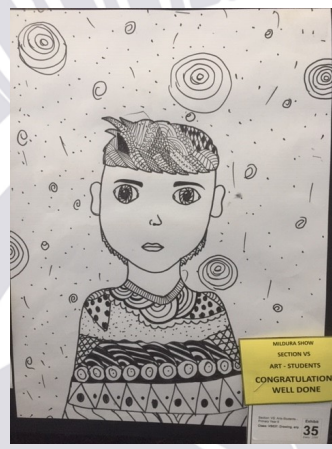

Meet Ms Davids in the Science Lab and overload your senses with slime. Do you have what it takes to stand on slime without sinking? Lets find out!



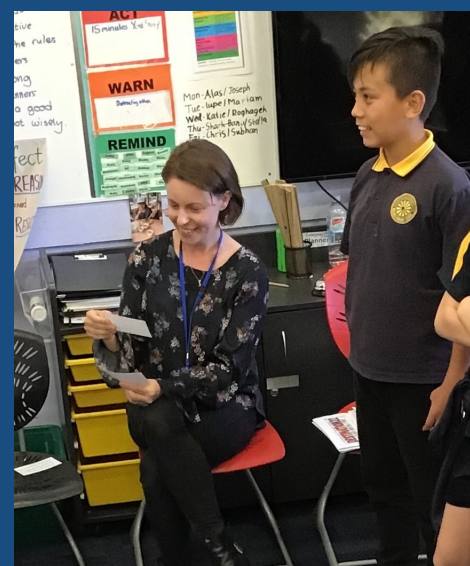
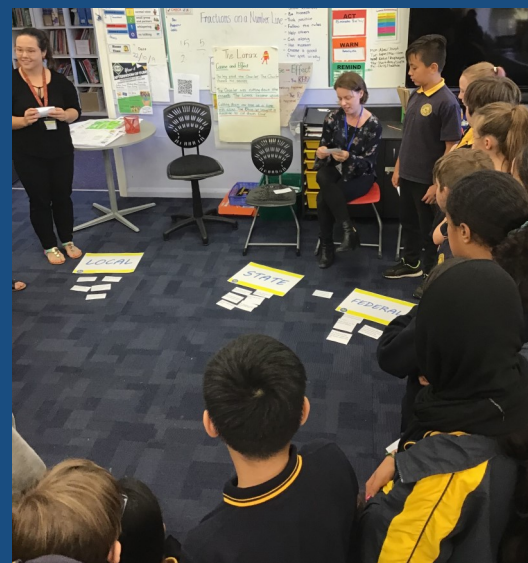
